STUDENT BEHAVIOR ON DISTRICT VEHICLES</p> <p>When students are transported by school bus or district vehicle, it is very important that students behave in a manner that does not distract the driver from operating the vehicle safely and ensures the safety of all students.</p> <p>This policy shall apply to all students being transported in any type of school district vehicle, whether that be a school bus or school van.</p> <p>The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for developing and publicizing a Discipline Code for students who ride on district vehicles. This Discipline Code should be published in conjunction with the discipline procedures for students while attending school. This should be included in a student and parent handbook or other similar document that is available to all students and parents/guardians.</p> <p>All procedures regarding student behavior on buses also applies to student behavior at the bus stop. Students should wait for the bus in a safe area well off the roadway. Littering, throwing things, damaging property, or other physical play is unacceptable.</p> <p>When exiting the bus to cross the street, students must cross only in front of the bus, making eye contact with the driver before proceeding. Students should never cross at the rear of the bus.</p> <p>In the case of serious discipline concerns or suspected criminal activity on the part of students, the administrator in charge may suspend a student from bus privileges immediately. The school district reserves its right to press civil or criminal charges in the appropriate court for behaviors that are of such severity to warrant such action.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
