Re: *Free and Reduced Eligibility Carry Over*

If your son/daughter received a free or reduced lunch during the month of June 2011, he/she will be eligible as a carry over for lunch during the first 30 school days. **You must file a new application form by October 12, 2011**, and be approved for whichever category of eligibility by the Food Service Director, in order to qualify for this benefit for the 2011-2012 school year.

Throughout the year, you must inform the school if your household size decreases or your income increases by more than \$50 per month or \$600 per year. If your children receive free meals because they get food stamps or TANF cash assistance, you must inform the school when you are no longer receiving food stamps or TANF cash assistance. You may then fill out another application giving income information.
