



FASD Virtual Academy Expectations

Admission to the Fleetwood Virtual Academy (FVA) will be based on an assessment of a student's academic background and a meeting with Fleetwood Area School District staff. The FVA curriculum may be delivered by Edgenuity teachers or Fleetwood Area School District teachers. The Fleetwood Area School District provides virtual school offerings through Fleetwood Virtual Academy.

Due to the mode of delivery for this type of educational setting, the family is most responsible for the education of their child. Fleetwood Area School District (FASD) recognizes the importance of consistent contact with certified teachers; therefore, the district requires a commitment from both the family, online provider, and FASD Virtual Academy Facilitator to maintain regular contact. Below are identified responsibilities for students and parents that can assist the student to be successful in a virtual school environment.

To ensure continuity of instruction a student may only enroll in the virtual school program at the beginning of a semester. Students may not enroll mid-semester.

Student Responsibilities:

- Students are expected to log in to their courses each district calendar day. Attendance is based on daily login to the FVA platform. Attendance expectations and truancy guidelines are applied to virtual students.
- Students will be provided with a 14-day trial and must demonstrate success otherwise; the student may be removed from the virtual academy program and re-enrolled in the brick mortar setting.
- To be successful, it is recommended that **1 hour is spent online for each subject daily**. Students should establish a routine that incorporates this expected learning time into their daily schedule
- Students will complete required coursework within the scheduled timeframe for each course.
- Students will communicate with his/her teacher and virtual academy facilitator on a regular basis.
- Students must take care of equipment borrowed from Fleetwood Area School District. If equipment is lost or damaged, the student/family will be responsible to pay for the repair or replacement of the equipment.
- All courses are required to be completed by the timeframe provided by FVA.

Family Responsibilities:

- The family will contact the virtual academy facilitator or course teacher for any issues related to content.
- Parents/family member are expected to monitor and keep track of attendance for their child. If a student will be absent student/parent/family member is expected to email the Virtual Academy Facilitator.
- The family has read the FASD Acceptable Use Policy (AUP).
- When in attendance at school events and coursework, students will abide by district policies.

- All provided materials (ex. books) must be returned in a timely manner in good condition.
- The student will be expected to report to his/her assigned school for state mandated assessments (PSSA, Keystone).
