## **Parent/Family Right-to-Know Annual Notification**

September 3, 2019

Dear Parents and Family Members,

Title I, Part A is a federal supplemental program designed to help children reach high academic standards. In receiving funds from this program the district is required to inform you of information available to you regarding the professional qualifications of your child's teachers.

In the Fleetwood Area School District, we are proud of our high-quality teachers and the education we provide our students daily. As a Title I school, we must meet federal regulations related to teacher qualifications as defined in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). These regulations allow you to learn more about your child's teachers' training and credentials. Upon request, we will provide you with the following information:

- Whether the teacher met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject he/she is teaching,
- Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived, and
- What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration.
- Whether your child receives support from a paraprofessional, and information about the paraprofessional's qualifications.
- Information on policies regarding student participation in assessments and procedures for opting out.
- Information on required assessments that may include subject matter tested, purpose of the test, source of the requirement, time that is allotted for students to complete the test, and the time and format of providing test results.

The Fleetwood Area School District is committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking skills needed to succeed in school and postgraduate years. That commitment includes that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals meet the applicable Pennsylvania state requirements.
